

## TRAVEL INFORMATION

### IF YOU ARE DRIVING

**Basic Driving Directions:** From NYC: Take Hutchinson River Pkwy North. Continue on Merritt and Wilbur Cross North Pkwy in CT. At Exit #68 Take #1-91 north to Hartford. OR take I-95 (New England) Thruway Exit to Rt. #1-91 toward Hartford. At Hartford, CT: Follow signs to I-84 East (to Boston), and on to Sturbridge, MA. At Sturbridge: Take Mass. Pike East to Exit #10 at (Rt. #290) Follow #290 East through Worcester to I-495 north, and on to I-95 north. Follow I-95, New Hampshire Toll Road, and Maine Tpk to Exit # 63 (Formerly Exit 11). Take Left at the end of the ramp. At first light take a right onto Route 26. Follow Rt. 26 for approx. 12 miles to intersection with Rt. 11. At intersection Turn left on Winterbrook Rd., ( just beyond the Mark's Five Corners Market.) Winterbrook Road will become Herrick Valley Road.) Go Approx 3 miles to end, turn Rt. onto MaGuire Hill Rd. Camp Fernwood Lane and Fernwood Gates will be 1/10th mile on the left.

### OTHER WAYS TO GET TO CAMP

We will pick you up in Portland, Maine, at the airport or at one of the two bus terminals (Concord Trailways or Greyhound/Vermont Transit). If something changes from your original arrival time and destination please call us that day. Until June 1, we are available at 888-295-4446. After June 1 please reach us at camp at 207-998-4346.

**There are four forms of transportation that will get you to Portland, Maine where you will be met by our camp van and driven the rest of the way (about 45 minutes) to camp in Poland, Maine. You may get to Portland any way you wish. Do your homework as some of these options can save on transportation costs:**

#### **#1. Flying into Portland Airport:**

Be sure you let us know your flight information, including: airline, departure time, departure city and arrival time. We will meet you at the baggage claim area.

#### **#2 Bus from Boston:**

If you fly or take a train to Boston, MA, you can take a **Concord Trailways** bus from Logan airport to Portland, Maine. (\$24 one-way, for more info call 800-639-3317, or check out the website [www.concordtrailways.com](http://www.concordtrailways.com). ) Concord Trailways picks up outside each terminal at Logan and also has a pick up from Boston's South station (Amtrack train station). The fares and schedule are subject to change, please call to check times and fares before booking travel.

#### **#3 Bus from anywhere else:**

You may also take a **Greyhound bus** to Portland, Maine. Their number is 800-231-2222 or check out their website, [www.greyhound.com](http://www.greyhound.com). Fares and schedules are subject to change, so be sure to call them first. (Average: \$42 one-way) Bus from New York: A typical bus schedule from New York City to Portland, Maine is another form on the website. In early summer, many counselors will be travelling to Maine camps at the same time you are. During the peak of travel to Maine, if Greyhound completely fills the scheduled bus, they will call for additional buses to leave in succession until all passengers have left, or until the next regularly scheduled bus is due to depart. We suggest arriving as early as you can for your actual scheduled bus.

#### **#4. Flying into Manchester, NH Airport:**

Manchester airport is sometimes a less expensive alternative to Logan Airport. You should look into this alternative destination to see if it will save you any money. If you are flying in to Manchester, NH, you will need to take the **Mermaid Transportation** shuttle bus to Portland airport where we will pick you up. You must book this bus at least 4 days in advance, fare: Approx: \$58, call 1-800-696-2463 <http://www.gomermaid.com/>).
